## 1) Receiving A Learners License "Permit"(Restriction 9); the student must:

- 1) Be 15  $\frac{1}{2}$  Years Old
- 2) Be Currently Receiving Instruction in a Driver Education Program
- 3) Have 2 Forms of ID (State Issued Birth Certificate or Passport and a SS Card, School ID or Parent Affidavit)
- 4) Have Social Security Number
- 5) Have School Letter (Includes Proof of Enrollment in School and Passing Grade on the 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Reading Test).
- 6) Have Merkley's Driving School Registration Form or Completion Certificate
- 7) Pass the Vision & Written Test (75%) at the Department of Public Safety.  
(If student completes Driver Education before getting a permit; the written test portion of the process will be waived).

**\*\*\* Now they can drive with a licensed driver 21 or older sitting in the front seat between the hours of 5am-10pm.**

## 2) In Order to Get a Intermediate License (Restriction G) the student must:

- 1) Be at least 16 years old.
- 2) Have had a permit for 6 months with no accidents or tickets
- 3) Have driven 50 hours with a permit; 10 of those hours at night.  
(The Affidavit must be Signed and Notarized). Form located at [www.merkleys.com](http://www.merkleys.com)
- 4) Have Completed Driver Training Program and have Certificate of Completion
- 5) Pass The Driving Test (75%) at the Merkley's or the DPS.

**\*\*\* Now they can drive by themselves and have 1 friend in the car or have as many family members living in the same household in the car with them. They cannot drive between the hours of 10pm - 5am unless it is a school, work or church related activity. Restrictions don't apply if licensed driver 21 or older is in front seat.**

## 3) Students 18 or older:

- 1) No Permit is required. Take Written & driving test with proper ID & SS # at DPS.
- 2) If you get a permit; you must have it 30 days before taking the driving test.
- 3) If you complete driver education; the written test can be waived and you may take the driving test after 30 days at Merkley's or any DPS exam site.

## 4) Rules for Taking the Driving Test at Merkley's:

- \* Complete a driver education program and have an Oklahoma Permit.
- \* Update License info in Account
- \* Select a Testing Package
- \* Follow Instructions in the Portal
- \* Driving Skills!!!!!!
