

Thank you for choosing Merkley's Driving School for your driver training.

Bring:

- 1) Pen/Paper for Notes
- 2) Bring a lunch or \$5 for pizza
- 3) Oklahoma Drivers Manual (Available at local Tag Agency's; \$4.50) or use phone/tablet. We will have a classroom set of manuals to use.
- 4) App Store "OK DPS" for a free manual and practice questions.

Once classes begin on Monday; all students who are 15 1/2 are eligible to get a permit at the Department of Public Safety. (28 E. Main St in Edmond).

Appointments can be made online for the PERMIT.

- 1) Go to www.merkleys.com
- 2) click on the link at the bottom of the home page.
- 3) You may also show up and take a number if no appointments are available on the day you want.
- 4) Just take a number and they will get to you as soon as possible.

Things to take to get the Permit at DPS

- 1) 2 Forms of ID (1 must be: Birth Certificate or Passport) NO COPIES
- 2) Social Security Number
- 3) School Letter (Proof of enrollment & shows they passed the 8th grade reading test).
- 4) Registration Form from Merkley's or Completion Certificate from Merkley's.

They will take a 20 question multiple choice test. (75% Required).

*WRITTEN TEST will be WAIVED for the permit if the student has completed the 10 hours of class AND all 6 hours of driving.

Schedule Driving Times:

- 1) go to www.merkleys.com
- 2) login (Username & Password will be sent as soon as classes begin)
- 3) Click on "schedule my driving"
- 4) Select the day and time and the pickup location.
- 5) Then click on SCHEDULE.

Testing Packages:

Students can take the driving test at Merkley's after having the permit for 6 months or 30 days if the student is 18 or older.

- 1) go to www.merkleys.com
- 2) login with username/password
- 3) Click on "Purchase" and select the testing package that works best for you. (Additional Fees Apply).
- 4) Click on "Student Info" and update license information so student will be ready to test.
- 5) Click on Contact and Request the Day/Date/Time for Test.
