Class Days Bring:

- 1) Pen/Paper for Notes
- 2) Bring a lunch or \$5 for pizza
- 3) Oklahoma Drivers Manual (We will have a classroom set of manuals to use.) Or... merkleys.com, click forms, click Drivers Manuel.

Once classes begin, all students who are 15 1/2 are eligible to get a permit at the Department of Public Safety. (Not a tag agency)

Make your apt 2 MONTHS in advance. Appointments can be made online for the PERMIT.

- 1) Go to www.merkleys.com
- 2) Click the tab "DPS Info", click Here to make <u>DPS apt.</u>
- 3) You may also show up and take a number if no appointments are available on the day you want. Expect a long wait and to get there EARLY. Each location is different.

Things to take to get the Permit at DPS

- 1) 1 Forms of ID (1 must be: Birth Certificate or Passport) NO COPIES
- 2) Social Security Number
- 3) Registration Form from Merkley's or Completion Certificate from Merkley's.

(Registration Form/Contract and agreement you get Day 1 of class, Completion Certificate/Golden Ticket you get on your third drive time)

With the Registration form, they will take a 20 question multiple choice test. (75% Required).

OPTION for Real ID, additional documents to take:

- 4) Social Security CARD
- 5) Two forms of residency.

*WRITTEN TEST will be WAIVED for the permit if the student has completed the 10 hours of class AND all 6 hours of driving. (Golden Ticket)

Schedule Driving Times:

- 1) go to www.merkleys.com
- 2) login (Username & Password will be sent as soon as classes begin)
- 3) Click on "scheduling", and "schedule my drive"
- 4) Select the day and time and the pickup location.
- 5) Then click on SCHEDULE.

Testing Packages:

Students can take the driving test at Merkley's after having the permit for 6 months or 30 days if the student is 18 or older.

- 1) Go to www.merkleys.com
- 2) Click "services"
- 3) Click "Drive Test Request"

This form does not charge you. If you have a package already you will select each service.
